What Diabetes Management Skills will participants learn?

- Enhance Diabetes Management Skills: Train nursing home staff on diabetes pathophysiology, complications, and interventions, including blood glucose monitoring, medication administration, and tailored dietary recommendations for older adults.
- Improve Patient-Centered Care and Communication: Promote empathy and effective communication, teaching clinicians to understand residents' preferences and involve them and their families in care decisions to align plans with their values.
- Promote Interdisciplinary Collaboration and Problem-Solving: Foster teamwork among healthcare professionals, training staff to collaborate with providers and specialists to create comprehensive care plans for older adults with diabetes.
