What is the IP Geek Infection Prevention Program?

This is a comprehensive 12-week course designed to enhance participants' knowledge and skills in infection prevention. The program covers a wide range of topics, including hygiene practices, infection control protocols, and other topics.

Who can participate in the IP Geek Infection Prevention Program?

The program is open for staff in Infection Prevention related roles, or for IP Champions at their facility, and is interested in improving their understanding of IP.

How is the program delivered?

- 6 Didactic Sessions (2 per month)
- 3 Coaching/Networking Calls (1 per month)
